Thomas Streiff joined BHP – Bruggler and Partners Ltd. in August 2004. During his assignment as research assistant at the Institute of Food Science and Nutrition of ETH Zurich where he promoted in 1989 he was teacher at a technical high school and later lecturer at the Postgraduate Course for Developing Countries (NADEL/ETH).

Thomas was delegate and advisor of several associations, foundations and committees such as World Business Council for Sustainable Development, United Nations Environment Programme – Finance Initiative, IMD-Corporate Sustainability Management Forum, Swiss Centre for Environmental Training and Sustainability and the UN Commission for Sustainable Development (CSD-12).
